Key knowledge

To know what **collage** is.

Key vocabulary

collage- a piece of art created by sticking paper, pictures and/or small objects onto a surface.

cut- use scissors to snip paper/pictures.
tear- use fingers to pull paper/ pictures
apart.

texture - the feel / appearance of a surface.

collaboration – to work as a group to produce something, eg a collage.

individually - to work alone to produce something, eg. a collage
